

## Havelock Band Expenses by Ensemble

Our goal is to have as many students as possible participate in our ensembles. Some of our ensemble cost more than others depending on the trips, instruction, etc. for that ensemble. This should help you in the planning for the ensembles you children sign up for.

### Jazz Ensemble Expenses

- Cost for binder, sheet protectors, reeds and accessories
- Possible overnight trip or day trip in the spring
- Tux rental or dress purchase estimate \$85

### Concert Band Expenses:

- \$4 bow tie (for males), cost of a binder and sheet protectors, reeds and accessories.
- Students must have Concert Attire consisting of Black pants and a white blouse. Girls may opt to wear a skirt, but it must be past the knees in length.
- Shoes should be black dress shoes.
- Possible Spring Trip

### Symphonic Band Expenses:

- \$4 bow tie (for males), cost of a binder and sheet protector, reeds and accessories.
- Students must have Concert Attire consisting of Black pants and a white blouse. Girls may opt to wear a skirt, but it must be past the knees in length.
- Shoes should be black dress shoes.
- Possible Spring Trip

### Wind Ensemble Expenses

- Tux rental or dress purchase estimate \$85
- Shoes should be black dress shoes.
- Possible Spring Trip

### Panache (Indoor guard group)

- \$100-\$125 for uniform
- \$50 - \$75 transportation fee
- \$100 for finals trip

### Marching Band Expenses:

- Approximately \$125      *Marching Band Camp*
- Approximately \$200      *Guard fee (Colorguard only) – do not sign up for the Marching Band Class if interested in Colorguard.*
- Approximately \$100- \$150      *Fall Trip (overnight) Fall trip has not been determined for 2010*
- \$35 Dry Cleaning Fee
- \$45 Uniform Jacket
- \$28 Marching Band Shoes (NO GUARD MEMBERS)
- \$3 Marching Band Gloves (preferably two pairs) (NO GUARD OR PERCUSSION MEMBERS)
- Cost for binder, sheet protectors, reeds and accessories
- Spending money/money for food during competitions

Marching Band is a large investment of time and money. Students will not have to pay in full before participating in Marching Band; they will be able to pay throughout the semester. Students will also be able to raise money through the many fundraisers that we participate in. A percentage of the profit from each fundraiser the student participates in will go into a personal student account. Students may use this money to pay for any band fees owed. Account balances must be paid in full by the end of the semester to be eligible to participate in Marching Band the next year.
